ACTIP is an independent non-profit association of European companies and institutions engaged in use of advanced cell technology for research, development and/or production of biotherapeutics. objectives are to bring cell technology experts together for networking, keeping up to date on cut developments and focus on technological and applied-oriented challenges for the industrial use of ACTIP's members meet twice a year at a plenary scientific meeting. How to apply

Applicants should be younger than 35 years of age, educated to at least degree level in one of the disciplines underlying biomanufacturing and based in Europe. The applicant should apply for the award using the application form available on the ACTIP website (https://www.actip.org). An application should be accompanied by a recent Curriculum Vitae (CV) with full contact details.

Timeline to apply

Fellowship award applications can be sent in from 25 January until 28 February 2023 (23:59 CET). Selected scientists will be notified by end of March 2023 and invited to an ACTIP meeting taking place in Autumn 2023 or Spring 2024. A shortlist of award winners and their projects will be published on the ACTIP website.
